COURSE DESCRIPTION

Paediatric transplantation (PT), like solid organ transplantation (SOT) or haematopoietic stem cell transplantation (HSCT), is a rare and high-complex procedure that requires a standardised approach to ensure equal access and safe patient care. The unique features of PT, including a low number of cases, young age and low weight, immune system immaturity and plasticity, transition from childhood to adulthood and long life expectancy, require the transfer of specific knowledge, techniques and innovative medicine to paediatric patients.

The main aim of this course is the training of medical professionals in the area of paediatric transplantation (PT) with a transversal approach that allows a multidisciplinary view of the most relevant issues in the transplant phases and practical knowledge of best clinical practices. The latest information on donor graft optimization and engineering, new patient graft tolerance tools, and psychosocial care for families, patients, and healthcare team will allow participants an up-to-date review of pediatric transplantation.

To evaluate paediatric transplantation in all its phases, pretransplantation, transplantation and post-transplantation.

Identify the most relevant issues to promote graft optimization, tolerance and psychosocial issues.

To apply the knowledge acquired through clinical cases of transplanted patients.

Recognize possible gaps in the care of transplanted children and encourage tools in medical care that allow for better clinical practices.

TARGET AUDIENCE

Health professionals involved in organ donation, particularly those working in referral units, such as: paediatric gastroenterologists, neonatologists, intensive care physicians, surgeons, emergency physicians, paediatric hematologists and oncologists, paediatric nurses, medical assistants, paediatric dieticians and nutritionists, home care providers, paediatric case managers, social workers, and all other physicians who are interested in the diagnosis and treatment of digestive disorders in infants and children.
